

COVID-19 Inspection Checklist

- Potential exposure based on task?
- Contact with public?
- Objects and surfaces commonly touched and enhanced cleaning and hand wash stations?
- Disinfectants available for cleaning?
- Availability and proper use of PPE?
- Worker and supervisor understanding of modes of transmission?
- Worker and supervisor understanding of control measures implemented in the Exposure Control Plan?
- Do workers know how and to whom to report possible exposures?

The following checklist is provided to give guidance.

This virus has introduced a new hazard into workplaces. The checklist is not intended to consider every risk factor at each workplace but rather it is intended to help committee members determine the effectiveness of control measures required and implemented to keep workers safe. Nothing about the pandemic changes the employer's responsibility to conduct regular workplace inspections and to conduct incident investigations. The presence of this new hazard in workplaces increases the role and the importance of joint occupational health and safety committee members in supporting worker safety.
